The following is a working definition of Twice-exceptional learners taken from *Gifted Child Quarterly 2014, Vol.58(3)* by Reis, Baum, and Burke.

Twice-exceptional Learners are students who demonstrate the potential for high achievement, or creative productivity in one or more domains such as; math, science, technology, the social arts, the visual, spatial, or performing arts or other areas of human productivity AND who manifest one or more disabilities as defined by federal or state eligibility criteria.

We strive to work quality GT services into the students Individual Education Plan. Services may look different for each individual student. It might be specifically designed lesson plans, classes in areas of specific interest or learning activities outside of the regular classroom. It might even be social emotional support for frustrations dealing with limitations. Whatever the need, we want **the student** to succeed!
